Who We Serve

Assessment, Consultation & Counselling services are available to children and/or adolescents who are placed within our treatment foster homes. We serve the east/ west and central regions of Ontario. We provide care for hard to service children who may have severe mental health, developmental, behavioural and emotional issues.

Individual Counselling is an essential treatment component in stabilizing and helping children cope with their life stressors and this can be provided through individual, family or group therapy. Individual needs are always considered and every effort is made to customize services to address the unique circumstances of each client and/ or family.

Family Counselling is offered through Johnson Children's Services along with ongoing consultations with foster parents to help support the home where the child resides and during access visits with their biological family. The involvement of parents and caregivers is valued and encouraged, although not always required. If family reunification is one of the goals for the child then we work together towards achieving that goal made in conjunction with the placing agency.

Group Counselling is offered through Johnson Children's Services on issues that affect our kids on a daily basis. Our agency will also assist with referrals to outside agencies for specialized treatment regarding sexual abuse, drug and alcohol addictions, sexual offending, etc.

Intake Process

Within the first week of placement within Johnson Children's Services, the process for clinical counselling will begin. At the 7-day visit, the CAS worker will be given a Clinical Intake Form, which is to be filled out and faxed back to the Head Office at the workers earliest convenience.

Prompt return of this form will allow for an agency therapist to review the information and arrange seeing the child to carry out an Initial Assessment. This assessment will be based on an interview with the child and the foster parent, as well as referral information. This initial assessment will be reviewed at the 30-day Plan of Care, and all parties in attendance will discuss a plan for clinical intervention



Therapists and Counsellors:

Johnson Children's Services currently has a clinical treatment team of MSW Social Workers, a psychologist and Child & Youth Workers. Our clinicians provide initial assessments and ongoing treatment for children in our care

Children in care are offered 1-2 hours of counselling a month, based on need. Weekly sessions are available as well if requested by a child's family worker.
